Age groups / distances: (For prize categories) (Based on age at 31 December 2025)

- **75km**
 - Elite 19-29 / Sub-Vet 30-39 / Vet 40-49 / Master 50-59 Men / Gr Master 60+
 - Black on white number boards
- **50km**
 - (For Gauteng XCM series points will be awarded for Master Women, Gr Master Men & Women on the 50km and not on the 75km)
 - Youth 15-16 / Junior 17-18
 - Red on white number boards
- **25km**
 - Nippers U11 / Sprogs 11-12 / Sub Junior 13-15
 - Green on white number boards

Route description:

- The routes will be a mixture of gravel, jeep tracks and single tracks.
- The 75km, 50km and 25km will do a 1km section next to the R59 on the way back. You have to stay on the concrete section. Do not ride on the tar. Marshalls will check that riders keep on the concrete section. Please treat this as if it's a single track.
- **Splits: 25km** split left at 13km. The **50km** split with the 75km will be at the top of Eyer of Africa at the gate where the 50km will go straight and the 75km turn right.
- Please allow front riders to pass if needed, especially on the section next to the highway coming back.
- Tar road crossings. Marshall will be at these crossings. Please be careful.

- **75km** (Final distance **74.12km / 950m Asc**)
- **50km** (Final distance **49.6km / 420m Asc**)
- **25km** (Final distance **24.7km – 200m Asc**)

Registration and number collection times and dates:

- You will receive a sms with your race number before first registration. Please bring this to registration.
- Friday 23 May at Café du Cirque 12h00 to 16h00.
- Sunday at the venue from 6h00.

Timing and prize giving:

- Timing by SSTiming.
- Number boards with timing chip included will be issued at registration.
- Number boards must be returned after the event.
- Number boards must be attached to your handlebars facing forward.
- Results will be live on www.spectrumsport.co.za
- Category results will be printed and on display at the finish area.
- Prize winners must be present at prize giving to receive prize.
- Prize giving will take place next to the finish area.

- Prize giving per distance will take place as soon as prize winners are in. Announcements will be made accordingly. Prize winners need to be present to receive their prize.
- Category winners will receive trophy, overall winners will receive cash.

Race rules:

- Final race briefing will be at the start 10min before each distance.
- CSA rules will apply.
- E-Bikes may only take part in 50km E-Bike race according to CSA rules.
- Riders on standard mountain bikes may not slip behind E-Bike riders.
- Any results issues must be sorted with the race officials before prize giving commences.
- The Winter Fast One MTB will be part of the Gauteng Provincial XCM series.
- Riders taking part in the series must start in A batch and must have a valid CSA license. Day licenses for the series will not be accepted.
- If you have an appeal, it must go through the race commissair directly. A fee may be payable to CSA if needed.

Bike wash available at the finish at a fee of R50 per bike.

Medals to all finishers.

Riders and clubs may bring gazebos to set up close to the finish area.
