CIRCULAR 7 OF 2022: AGN 21,1 KM CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022

Dear AGN Members,

Circular 4 of 2022 has bearing.

There has been some confusion regarding the Athletics Gauteng North (AGN) Provincial Half Marathon Championships incorporated with the Nedbank RC Skosana Race that will be taking place on 12 February 2021 at Pierre van Ryneveld Community Church (14 Baltimore Road, Pierre van Ryneveld Park, Centurion).

Please note that only athletes entering for the AGN Provincial Half Marathon Championships should be a registered AGN athlete with a 2021 or 2022 permanent license and will be required to wear their license during the Championships race. Athletes may not run with another athlete's permanent license and no temporary licenses will be allowed for the Championships.

Athletes entering for the Nedbank RC Skosana Race are allowed to participate with a temporary license. Temporary licenses will be available on race day.
